RESOLUTION 2026 - 02**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE ELECTION COMMISSION OF  
THE PROPOSED MUNICIPALITY OF NIWOT CALLING FOR AN ELECTION ON  
TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 3, 2026**

**WHEREAS**, on May 21, 2026, the Boulder County District Court entered an order finding and determining that the territory of the proposed Municipality of Niwot and the circulated petition met the requirements of § 31-2-101, C.R.S., and appointing six individuals to serve as commissioners for purposes of organizing the incorporation election; and

**WHEREAS**, the six individuals appointed to serve as commissioners for the Election Commission submitted affidavits accepting the appointments to the Court; and

**WHEREAS**, those six individuals comprise the Election Commission of the proposed Municipality of Niwot and its primary purpose is to coordinate the election for the incorporation of the proposed Municipality of Niwot; and

**WHEREAS**, the Election Commission will also coordinate the election on the question of the formation of a charter commission and election of charter commission members; and

**WHEREAS**, the Election Commission held its first meeting on June 8, 2026; and

**WHEREAS**, at its first meeting, the Election Commission calls for an election as set forth in this resolution.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ELECTION COMMISSION OF  
THE PROPOSED MUNICIPALITY OF NIWOT, COLORADO:**

Section 1. The Election Commission calls for an election to be held as a coordinated election with Boulder County on Tuesday, November 3, 2026. The issues for the election shall be the question of incorporation of the proposed Municipality of Niwot, Colorado; the formation of a Charter Commission; and the election of nine (9) Charter Commission Members. Additionally, the Election Commission shall place on the ballot the local government matters identified in the signed petitions that must be submitted to the eligible electors under Article X, Section 20 of the Colorado Constitution, including authorization to levy a sales and use tax, authorization to levy a marijuana special sales tax, authorization to levy a property tax, authorization to increase debt, and authorization to retain and spend all revenues.

Section 2. The Tuesday, November 3, 2026, election shall be conducted as a coordinated mail ballot election in accordance with, insofar as practicable, the incorporation statutes, Part 1, Article 2, Title 31, C.R.S.; the Municipal Home Rule Act of

1971, Part 2, Article 2, Title 31, C.R.S.; and, as applicable to the coordinated election, the Uniform Election Code of 1992, Articles 1 to 13 of Title 1, C.R.S.

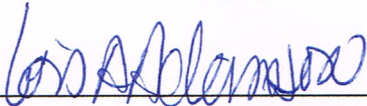
Section 3. As set forth in Resolution 2026-01, the Chairperson of the Election Commission shall serve as the Designated Election Official.

Section 4. The *Boulder Daily Camera* is designated as the legal publication for the notices of the Election Commission. Courtesy information may be provided in the *Longmont Times-Call* and the *Left Hand Valley Courier*.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect upon its approval by the Election Commission.
